LAMB, CALF & PET DAY - 10am this Saturday

... regardless of weather ...

Judging begins at 10am

All lamb and calf entrants please report to the appropriate desk on the school field to collect your Number Badge and be lined up ready for judging by 9.55am at the latest.

- **Pre-School** and **Junior Lambs** need to report to Miss Mitchell's desk at Ring 1
- **Intermediate** and **Senior Lambs** need to report to Miss McCourt's desk at Ring 2
- **Calves** need to report to Mrs Wood at the Calf Ring

Children and animals must stay close to the ring between events and listen out for your next instructions or you might miss the opportunity to show your animal.

Spectators please help support those showing lambs and calves by keeping other children off the play equipment (e.g. Mouse Wheels and Swings) as this is distracting for the animals.

PETS are to be put on the concrete behind Mrs Leigh's office - if wet they can be put on the deck of Room 4. Children please stay with your pet until Mrs Van den Brink and Mrs Blatchford have spoken to you. All pets must be securely caged, with water and shade available. A reminder that there are **NO DOGS** in the school grounds.

A **FREE Sausage Sizzle** will be available to everyone, and the Tip Top Cart will be selling a variety of ice blocks for \$1 - \$2 (**cash only** so bring some coins).

Classrooms will be open at 11am for viewing Inside Exhibitions. Please note that **ALL Exhibits and Certificates Must Remain At School.** They will be sent home on Monday.

Parents please bring a plate of morning tea for the adults to share.

Your food can be dropped into the Library on your arrival and Debbie and Sarah will organise morning tea for the adults at the conclusion of the Lamb Judging.

Thank you to everyone for supporting us with this and we are looking forward to seeing everyone regardless of the weather.



If your child is no longer bringing the lamb, calf or pet that they entered please advise Debbie first thing tomorrow morning. Judging lists need to be accurate.

DIARIES must be handed into the office before **9am** tomorrow for judging.

GARDEN COMPETITION INFORMATION:

- Garden plots must be a minimum of not less than **2 metres x 1.5 metres**
- The minimum size of the garden must be planted with a mixture of 4 or more varieties of vegetable.
- You may plant flowers to enhance your garden with natural pest control (e.g. marigolds to deter aphids), but these must be *outside* of the vegetable area.
- We generally recommend that gardens are planted at Labour Weekend to be ready for judging at the very end of Term 4.
- A school staff member will make a time to visit and judge the child's garden and a photo will be taken of the garden for the Manawatu Oroua Boys & Girls Agricultural Club to confirm your entry (in order for points to be awarded towards the Craig Cup).
- The gardener will need to be on site when their garden is judged to explain their plot to the judge.



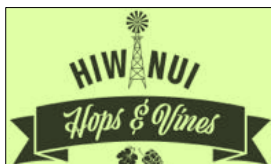
JUNIOR NETBALL

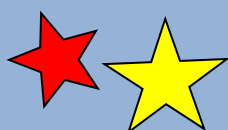

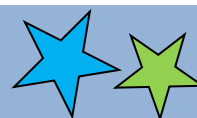
