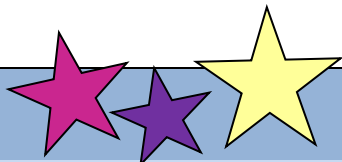

Wondering 1: **Isla Hansen** - *you are persevering with your story writing. You are using your 'spelling fingers' to help you write some big words.*

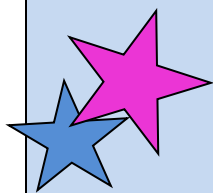
Terrific 2: **Benjamin Jones** - *you are a diligent and self-managing student. You show both commitment and enthusiasm in your learning. Ka pai!*
