Room 3: **Nate Kinaston** - *you are enthusiastic about encouraging others to be the best they can be. The humour in your writing is superb.*

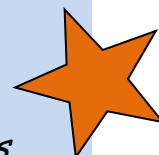
Room 4: **Scott Greenlees** - *you are always demonstrating commitment and perseverance as you take on extra duties in class and around the school. Thank you Scott.*
