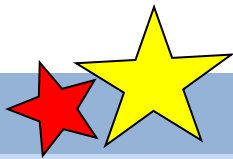

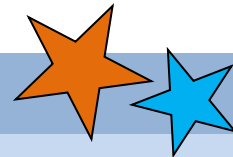


" ALADDIN JUNIOR "

Explorers: **Hannah Spear** - you are developing leadership skills and completing tasks to a high standard. Ka pai.

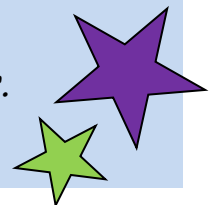
Terrific 2: **Abigail Probert** - you are a committed and respectful student, and I appreciate your helpfulness in the classroom. Ka pai.
