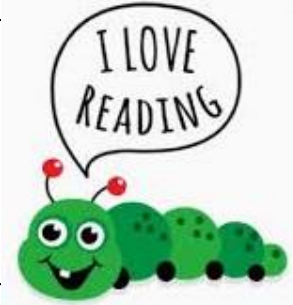




# Hiwinui School
