Hiwinui School Lamb, Calf & Pet Day

Saturday 30th October

(latest organisation as at 28/10/2021)

- Animals and carers need to be on site and registered by 9.30am
- Judging begins at 10am for Lambs, Calves and Pets

We know that many of us will be extremely disappointed in the information that follows, however we have done the very best we can with the Government's COVID directives. The Level 2 restrictions for schools have been clarified.

As soon as parents/judges etc. enter the school grounds on Lamb, Calf & Pet Day the rules for gatherings apply (meaning a maximum of 100 people onsite at any one time).

- Therefore, only parents of children with Lambs, Calves and Pets may attend this year. Two adults per family maximum please.
- All attendees, including staff, must be wearing a mask at all times. This does not include visitors under 12. Students 12 and over must also wear a mask. Students may remove their masks when in the ring handling their animals.
- QR Please sign in using either the QR code, or sign in via a paper copy. QR codes and paper copies will be available at the Lamb, Calf & Pet sign in decks and all doors at school.
- 1 metre distance must be adhered to at all times.

Classrooms will not be opened this year however the students will get the opportunity to go into their classrooms after the judging has happened and a video will be made of all exhibits and shared on each class Seesaw Account.



- The <u>Calf Ring</u> will be set up by the rugby goal post and we ask that parents bringing in calves enter via Melford Lane. Please park closely around the calf ring but allowing the animals and handlers space. This is the NAIT number you will use for transporting your calves to and from Pet Day this year: **12672462**
- The <u>Lamb Rings</u> will be in the same place please begin parking in the school Car Park or on the playground.
- <u>Pet owners</u> park in the Cark Park if possible. All pets must be appropriately tethered / caged and have fresh water available.
- There will be a Coffee Cart on site but remember your 1 metre distancing while waiting in line.
- The Hesseltines will be selling ice blocks for \$1 and \$2 cash only.
- The BBQ will be cooking sausages parents could you please go and get your family their sausages. Once again remember your 1 metre distancing. No cost for sausages.
- There will be no morning tea served.
